Tekia, Shevarim, Teruah Help Us Remember

Rabbinic tradition teaches all Jewish souls were present at Sinai to hear the first sounding of the shofar announcing the *brit* between Ad-nai and all People of Israel.

The Torah instructs us to remember that moment with sounds of the shofar on Rosh Hashanah. Tekia, Shevarim, Teruah help us to remember the emotions of *brit*-unity-peoplehood at Sinai and connection to the Land of Israel – one of the chief pillars of that eternal *brit*.

Israel bonds were created just three years after the modern State of Israel was born. Since then the High Holy Days, the sounds of the Shofar, and Israel Bonds have been linked. In this year when Israel turned 75 it has never been easier to connect with Israel through the purchase of an Israel bond.
